Student Scholarship for Annual Florida Native Plant Society Conference

The mission of the Florida Native Plant Society (FNPS) is to promote the preservation, conservation and restoration of native plants and native plant communities of Florida. The FNPS Magnolia Student Scholarship for the Annual Native Plant Society Conference was established to provide travel funding for a student with interest in attending the conference.

Scholarship Description:

Each conference scholarship will cover conference registration and fees (including field trips, social events, membership fee). Applications are welcome from any actively enrolled, local undergraduate or graduate student of a higher education institution who wishes to attend the FNPS annual conference in May (conference information available at fnps.org). Applications will be reviewed by a committee appointed by the Chapter President. The scholarship winners will be notified by May 1 and will be provided with a reimbursement form and instructions. After the conference, the recipient is to provide the Chapter with a short article describing the conference experience to be distributed on the website, Facebook, and Ms. Magnolia, or a short (2-3 minutes) oral presentation at a Chapter meeting (meeting information available at magnolia.fnpschapters.org).

Application Requirements:

- Completed application form – may be filled out using Adobe Reader “Sign” tool and saved.
- Reason for interest – a short explanation (~250 words) in the body of your email transmittal.

Applications are announced on February 1st and are due by midnight on April 1st. Send all application materials together to: *magnoliachapter@gmail.com* and with “Student Scholarship for FNPS Conference” in the subject field.
